Cyborg and Mutant Rights Club

ARTICLE I

(Name of Club)

The name of this Club will be the Cyborg and Mutant Rights Club.

ARTICLE II

(Purpose of Club)

The club has been organized to discuss the ethical and societal implications of emerging bio-technologies, promote bodily autonomy and advocate for accessibility of science and technology.

ARTICLE III

(Authority)

The Club derives its authority directly from the Student Senate and indirectly from the College Board of Trustees.

ARTICLE IV

(Membership) (Mandatory)

Membership is open to all SBCC students regardless of their religious affiliations, gender, age, sexual orientation, ethnicity, etc.

ARTICLE V

(Meetings)

Regular meetings of the Club will be determined by the membership at its initial meeting each semester and reported to the Office of Student Life, room CC-217.

ARTICLE VI

(Officers)

President – Preside over all meetings. Call special meetings. Vice President – Supports presidents, takes over in his/her absence. Secretary – Records minutes of club meetings. Treasurer – Keeps financial record.

ARTICLE VII

(Elections) Officers shall serve 1 term(s) and will be elected each semester.

ARTICLE VIII

(Amendments)

The Constitution shall be amended upon the approval of 51% of the Club members.
