ARTICLE I

(Name of Club)

The name of this Club will be Free Club: Forgive, Rebuild, Educate, Encourage.

ARTICLE II

(Purpose of Club)

The club has been organized to assist in the construction of new thinking, by addressing old thoughts and behaviors.

ARTICLE III

(Authority)
