ARTICLE I

(Name of Club)

The name of this Club will be Society of Black Scientists and Engineers.

ARTICLE II

(Purpose of Club)

(Authority)

(Meetings)

(Officers)

President – Preside over all meetings. Call special meetings.

Vice President – Supports presidents, takes over in his/her absence.

Secretary – Records minutes of club meetings.

Treasurer – Keeps financial record.

ARTICLE VII

(Elections)

Officers shall serve 2 term(s) and will be elected each year.

(Amendments)

The Constitution shall be amended upon the approval of 50% of the Club members.
