ARTICLE I

(Name of Club)

The name of this Club as is currently stands is the World Finance and Economics Club at SBCC.

ARTICLE II

(Purpose of Club)

The World Finance and Economics Club has been organized in order to bring students interested in finance, economics, and geopolitics together in order to provide a common place for discussion, debate, research and student of topics pertaining to the global arena of finance and economics.

ARTICLE III

(Authority)

ARTICLE V

(Meetings)

Regular meetings of the Club will be determined by the membership at its initial meeting each semester and reported to the Office of Student Life, room CC-217.

ARTICLE VI

(Officers)

Co-Presidents – Plans oversees and presides over each club meeting.

Vice President – Aids in planning provides input for all meetings and presides over each meeting.

ARTICLE VII

(Elections)

Officers shall serve 2 term(s) and will be elected each semester.

ARTICLE VIII

(Amendments)

The Constitution shall be amended upon the approval of 2/3 of the Club members.
