3. Submit official transcripts from all colleges attended for verification of eligibility requirements.
4. Submit original or certified copies of all OFFICIAL secondary (3.0 G.P.A.) and post-secondary (2.4 G.P.A.) records including certificates, degrees or diplomas in original language of issue if student did not complete 60 transferable semester units.
5. Submit financial affidavit and bank statement. www.csun.edu/anr/forms/affidavit.pdf

Please note that the maximum number of units that may be transferred from community colleges to the CSU is 70. It is strongly recommended that you complete the lower division preparation for the major. However, it is not a requirement for admission.
